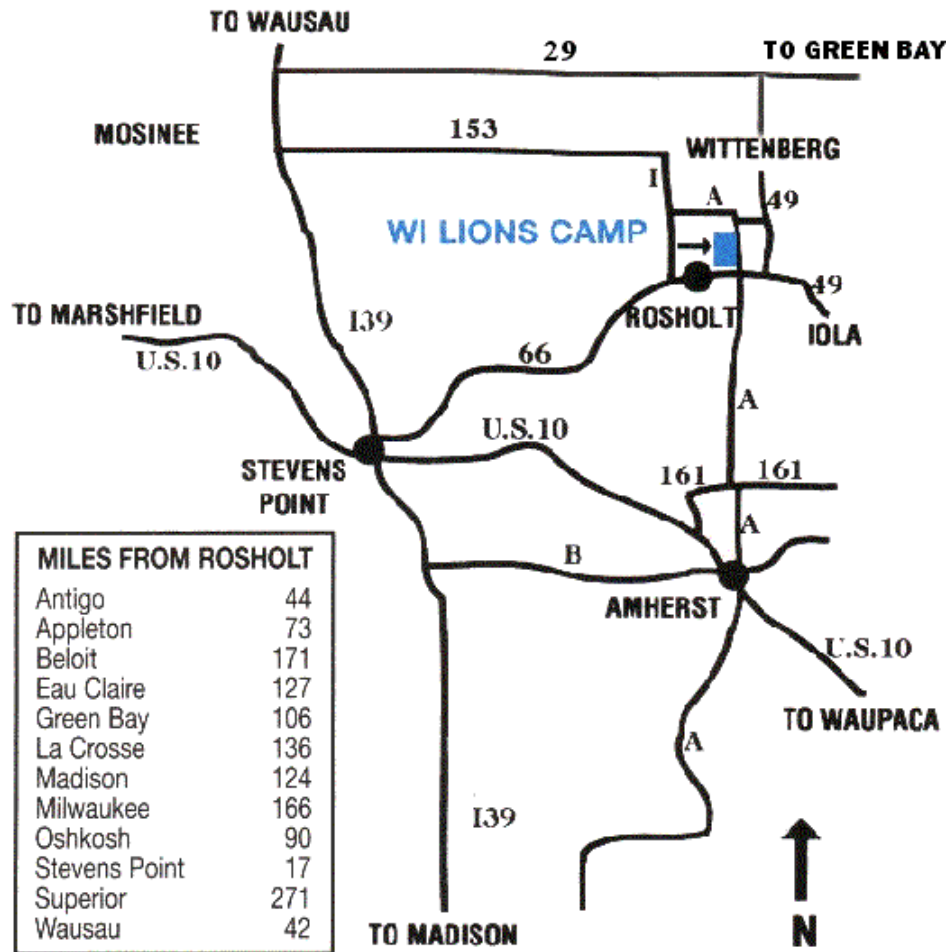

Traveling by CAR



First find Stevens Point, Wisconsin. It's in the middle of the state, on Hwys 51 (also known as I-39) and 10.

Now find Hwy 66, which leads northeast out of Stevens Point. The route to Lions Camp from Stevens Point is marked with obvious highway signs. Approximately 15 miles NE of Stevens Point on 66 you'll find the village of Rosholt. Follow 66 about another mile east from Rosholt and you'll be at County Hwy A, which might not appear on every map.

Go north on A from Hwy 66 about 1 to 1.5 miles. If your map is really good, you'll see Lions Lake. The camp is right there, just west of Hwy A.

If you come from the south or west, you'll probably go through Stevens Point. If you're coming from the east, you may want to go to Waupaca and catch Hwy 49 north. Go through Iola, and after another 8 or 10 miles you run into Hwy 66 a few miles EAST of Rosholt. Take 66 west to County Hwy A. This route is rich in scenic enjoyment.
